Greetings from HM Safety Certifications!-

Thank you for starting your journey to certification with HM Safety Certifications! We are dedicated and passionate about your future and what you decide to do with your certification after you complete our course and will take great strides to ensure that by the end of your course, you will have the competency and confidence to use your skills in a life-saving emergency.

Course Information

The American Red Cross blended learning course will prepare you to prevent, recognize and respond to emergencies. The eLearning portion of this class is scenario based and will introduce you to the skills that you will practice and master during the in-person skill sessions. Allow significant time to complete the eLearning portion, including any final eLearning exams. Once the online learning section is complete, the link will provide you a certificate showing that you completed the section. Make sure you save an image of that certificate on your phone or print the certificate out. The online learning section of the class must be completed prior to attending the classroom demonstrations. ***The online learning section must be completed prior to the first day of training. Students who do not provide their certification may be bumped to a future class.***

From our home page, visit the Resources Tab, find and select your online learning assignment. Once registered, you will be able to complete the online learning assignment for the course.

It is highly recommended that the online learning is completed on a PC or Mac, using Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Apple Safari, or Mozilla Firefox as your browser. Difficulties arise when completing the assignment on certain cellular devices and tablets, or on newer operating systems such as OperaGX.

Successful completion of this eLearning content alone will not result in certification. This eLearning content must be taken in conjunction with at least 19 hours and 45 minutes of in-person training and evaluation led by an American Red Cross Lifeguarding Instructor. To earn certification, participants must:

- Meet the age requirement – 15 years old on or before the final scheduled in-person session of the course.
- Pass the pre-course swimming skills evaluation.
- Attend and actively participate in all class sessions.
- Demonstrate competency in all required skills.
- Complete all eLearning modules and reading assignments as assigned by the instructor.
- Pass all final exams with a minimum grade of 80%.
- Pass all final skill scenarios.

Aquatic sessions may be moved to new facilities due to scheduling conflicts. Updates to the locations of aquatic sessions will be provided via email.

Students will spend their classroom time reviewing concepts from the online learning section and demonstrating competency in a hands-on environment. This includes lecture, videos, demonstrations, and critical thinking exercises. ***Students are to demonstrate competency in all areas in order to pass the class and receive their certification. Students who do not show competency in all areas will be bumped to a future class.*** Students who complete the online course and their classroom session will receive their two (2) year certification through the American Red Cross. Students will receive their certification via email, and it will be sent to the email associated with the online learning assignments.

Students who do not receive their certification will be eligible for a retake for the course. The retake will include the entire in-person session of the course, including all previously passed sections. Students will be slotted into available open slots dependent on current enrollment. The cost of the course retake will be \$50.

HM Safety Certifications Code of Conduct

- There are no refunds for the class. If you are removed from the class due to attendance or performance, then you will be bumped to a future class to complete your training. However, students removed from the class due to conduct will not be allowed to return.
